ADMISSIONS 2017 - 2018

Admissions application forms are being accepted as of October 18, 2016. Enrollment preference is given to siblings of current St. Viator students.

ADMISSIONS SCHEDULE

Below is a schedule of important dates in the Admission Process for the 2017-2018 school year

October 18, 2016 Applications for 2017 – 2018 school year now accepted.

February 24, 2017 Application deadline for **all new** students.

*Applications submitted after February 24, 2017 will be accepted on a rolling basis.

February 24, 2017 Priority enrollment with \$100 preregistration fee for current families ends.

February 26, 2017 FACTS site now open to apply for financial aid - Deadline for applications April 12, 2017

March 16, 2017 Acceptance letters mailed to all new families.

April 12, 2017 Acceptance forms due back

April 12, 2017 Financial Aid applications due

May 15, 2017 Preschool applications submitted after May 15th may be placed in a combined PK3/PK4 classroom

AGE REQUIREMENTS

3 Year old Preschool students must be 3 on or before September 1st (birthdate 09/01/2014 or before).

4 Year old Preschool students must be 4 on or before September 1st (birthdate 09/01/2013 or before).

Kindergarten students must be 5 years old on or before September 1st (birthdate 09/01/2012 or before).

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS - Prior to the first day of school

For transfer students in any grade, you must provide a copy of the student's most current medical, eye, and dental records. NEW exams, as shown below, are required for all students entering the following grades:

PreK 3 & 4 Medical* with the Lead Screening portion completed

Kindergarten Medical* with Lead Screening portion completed, Vision/Eye, and Dental

Grade 2 Dental

Grade 6 Medical*, including proof of new TDap and Meningococcal vaccinations, and Dental
